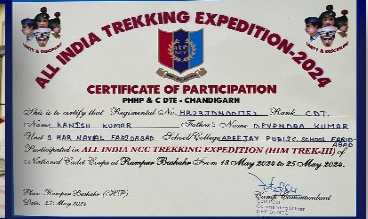
## BUILDING BRIDGES: ORIENTATION SESSION FOR PARENTS OF NEWLY ADMITTED

Students engaged in role plays, recitations and quizzes to foster a love for reading and copyright awareness. Students were encouraged to inculcate reading habits and respect intellectual property.



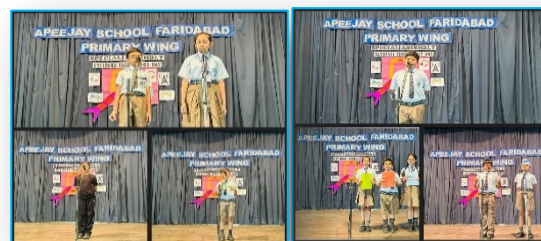
## INTERNATIONAL DANCE DAY

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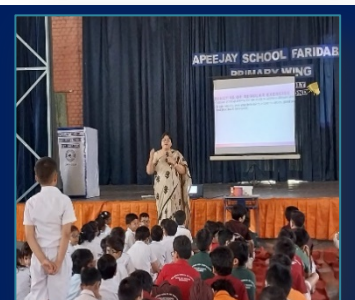
## FUELLING IMAGINATION, HONOURING CREATIVITY
