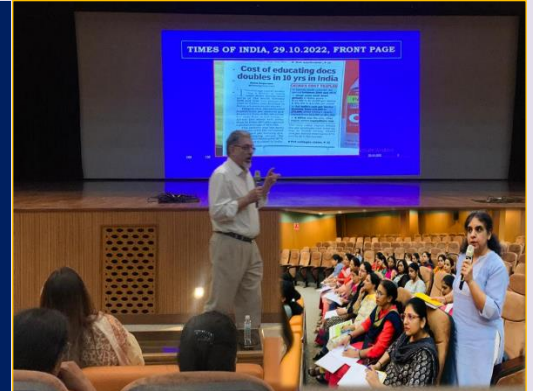
## WORKSHOP ON PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM SEXUAL OFFENCES

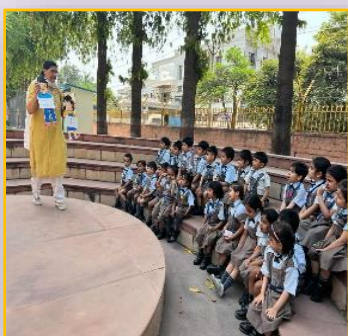
Mother's Day celebration had a plethora of activities like Crown and Card making for their loving mothers.
